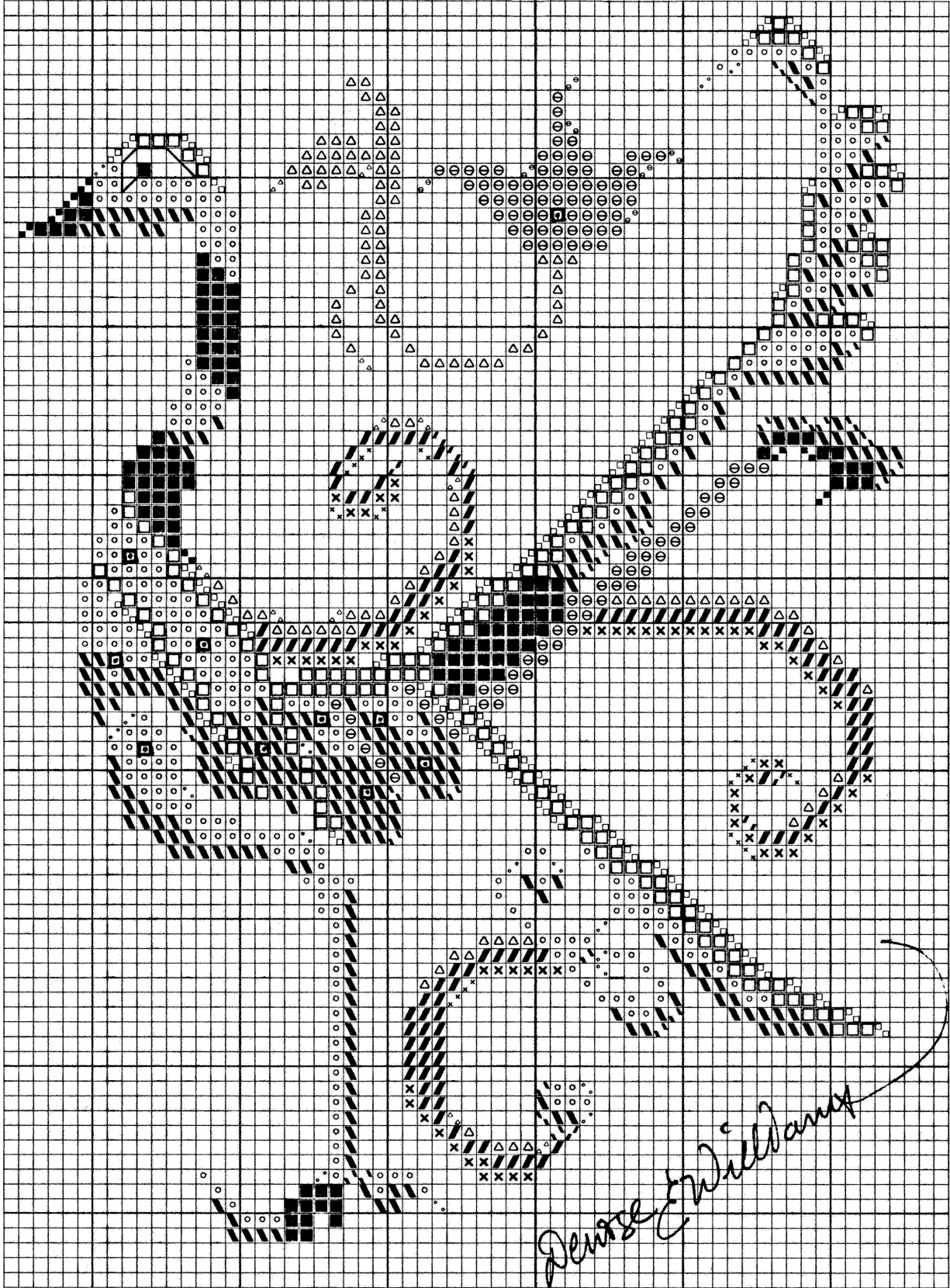


Han Phoenix from *Thai Die* by Monica Ferris

The Han Phoenix is stitched on gleaming white 28-count Jubilee fabric, in full- and half-cross stitches, over two rows, using two full strands of silk ("2 over 2").

*A photocopy enlargement of the pattern and key will make the stitch symbols easier to read.*

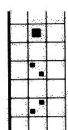
## Stitches

-  left half-cross stitch
-  right half-cross stitch
-  full-cross stitch
-  back stitch

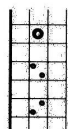
Outline eye in back stitch using Gloriana #011.

(Half-size symbols indicate left and right half-cross stitches.)



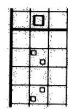

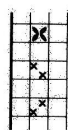


*Kreinik Silk Bella #7082 (or raw Thai silk)*

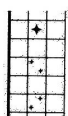


Stitch four full-cross stitches, one on top of another.

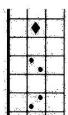
This makes a four layer full-cross stitch that is thick and big, resembling a knot.



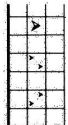
