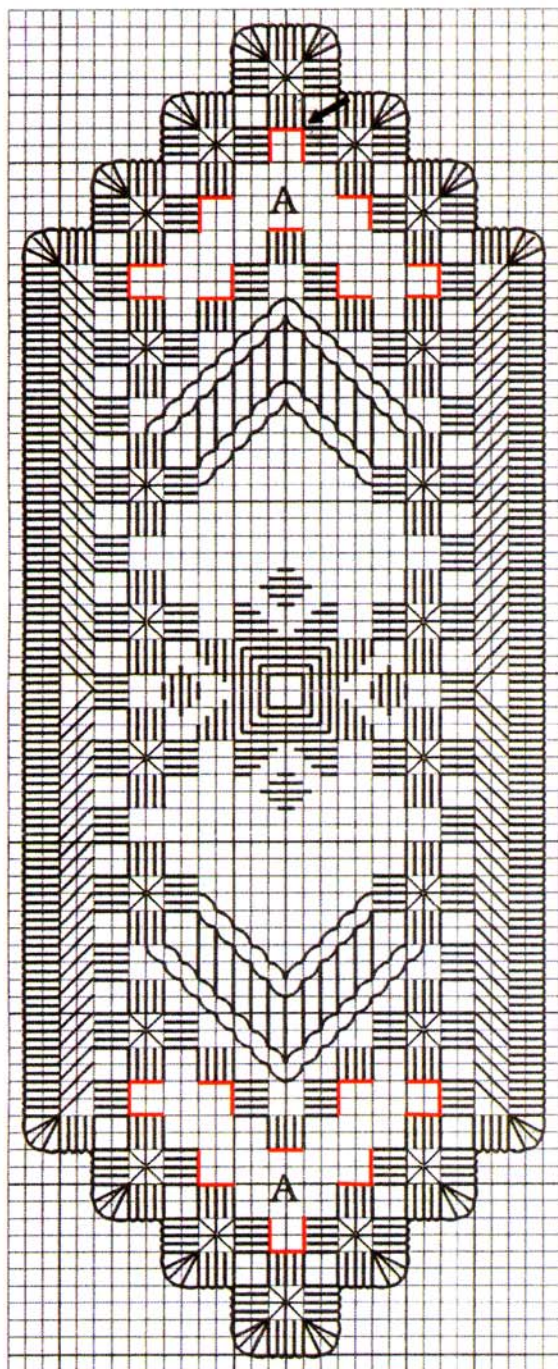

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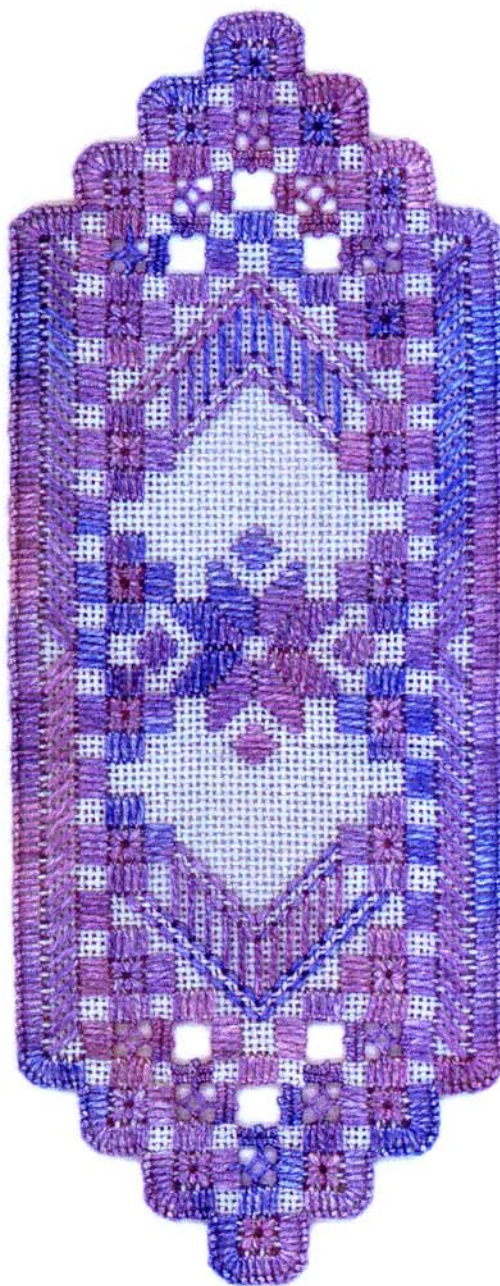

A - Woven bars, picots and webs
Every square of the chart
represents 2 x 2 fabric threads.

Finished size: 2 ½" x 6 3/8"

Materials: 5" x 9" 24 count Congress cloth, color pale blue (9406-594)

1 skein Leah's Overdyed size #8 pearl cotton, color Blue Orchid (LE008-40)

Working Instructions: Fold the fabric in half lengthwise to find the center line. Measure down 1.75" to begin the first satin stitch block. Work all the satin stitch blocks, solid motifs, buttonhole edge, partial eyelets, cable, diagonal and straight stitches. Continue with cutting where indicated in red on the chart, woven bars, picots and webs. Trim away excess fabric around the buttonhole edge. Press with right side down on a terry towel.
